Calix Customer's Fiber-To-The-Home Offering Named Winner in the Network Infrastructure Category

JUNE 20, 2007, PETALUMA, CA—Calix today announced that its customer Greenfield Communications was named a 2007 NXTComm Eos Award winner for its fiber-to-the-premises (FTTP) networks in California and Arizona. Greenfield, along with 12 other category winners, will be recognized tonight at a reception at NXTComm in Chicago.

Greenfield is currently the largest privately held FTTP communications provider in the country, based on the number of homes under contract.
